



FREQUENTLY QUESTIONS ASKED:

Q: How do I register?

A: Families can register for the 2024-2025 school year online through the Girls Inc/AIK website. Registration does not guarantee a space. We build our enrollment from the registrations and build our waitlist once we reach our limit. Each AIK Program/School Location has its own registration link. Each registration link will go live at on April 16, 22 and 29.

Q: How many children do you accept in AIK?

A: The number of children in our program varies per site based on Community Care Licensing Enrollment and Student Capacity.

Q: How will I know if I get a spot?

A: We will contact you via email and use the address provided on your registration. Please allow us up to one week to complete the registration process on our end and notify families of their placement.

Q: How much is the registration fee? When is my registration fee due?

A: Registration is a non-refundable fee of \$55.00 per child.

A. Registration Fees are due within 3 days on being notified of your enrollment.

Q: What if I don't get placement?

A: You will be placed on the Waitlist and will be notified by email once your status is confirmed. Our waitlist is fluid and changes are made weekly leading into the first week of school.

Q: Can I register at multiple schools?

A: NO. Unfortunately, you must be enrolled at the school you register for. Please verify the school before you complete your registration. Not doing so could jeopardize your space, as each site maintains a different list.

Q: When and how do I pay tuition (Monthly Fees)?

A: Tuition (Monthly Fees) invoices for August will be emailed the last week in July and payments are due *before* the first day of school. You will receive an invoice and payment link by the 15th of each month thereafter. The first and last month of care will be prorated. We will offer an optional auto-pay option for the 24-25 school year.

Q: Does AIK offer part-time care?

A: AIK does NOT offer part time care.

Q: Does AIK provide tuition assistance?

A: AIK does NOT provide tuition assistance or sibling discounts. assistance or sibling discounts.
