



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q: How do I register?

A: Families can register for the 2026-2027 school year online through the Girls Inc/AIK website (www.girlsincislandcity.org).

- Each AIK Program/School Location has its own registration link.
- Registration does not guarantee enrollment. This is your preregistration.

Q: How many children do you accept in AIK?

A: The number of children in our program varies per site based on space, enrollment and student capacity. Please see website (AIK Landing Page)

Q: How will I know if I get a spot?

A: We will contact you via email using the address provided on your registration. Please allow us up to 5 to 7 business days for a response.

Q: How much is the registration fee? When is my registration fee due?

A: Registration is a non-refundable fee of \$60.00 per child.

- Registration Fees are due within 48 hours after being notified of your enrollment.

Q: What if I don't get placement?

A: You will be placed on the Waitlist and will be notified by email once your status is confirmed. Our waitlist is fluid and changes are made as transfers and withdrawals occur.

Q: May I register at multiple schools?

A: No. You must enroll at the school your child is enrolled. Please verify the school before you complete your AIK registration.

Q: Does AIK offer part-time program care and or services?

A: No. AIK does NOT offer Part-Time program care and or services.

Q: Does AIK offer AUSD or siblings discounts?

A: No. AIK does NOT offer AUSD or siblings discounts.

Q: Does AIK offer tuition assistance?

A: No. AIK does NOT offer tuition assistance.

Q: Does AIK accept Childcare Subsidy program payments?

A: Yes. Alameda Island Kids & Girls Inc. reserves the right to consider and approve payment subsidized child care contracts based on space availability, contracted hours Plans (APP) needed, projected fees paid by the contracted agency of the following partnering organizations:

- Bananas, bananasbunch.org
- Davis Street Community Center, davisstreet.org
- Please be aware: A limited amount of contracts will be approved per school year by AIK.



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Q: Who should I contact if I have a question about my bill?

Q: When and how do I pay my AIK Tuition?

A: Tuition (Monthly Fees) payments are due on or before the first day of program each month.

- Invoices are mailed out on the 15th of each month prior to your care.
- Payment are to be made online through your www.MYPROCARE.com Account, the Procure Parent App or by mail.

Q: Who do I contact if I want to change/add an authorized pick-up person to my ProCare account?

A: To make any changes or additions to your child's authorized pick-ups you must communicate with your Site Director in writing, via email or text. Please allow up to 24 hrs. **after** receiving confirmation of changes made.

Q: Do you offer afternoon care for TK?

A: While we do offer morning (AM) care for TK Students at select sites (Bay Farm and Earhart), we do **NOT** offer afternoon (PM) care at any of our AIK sites.

Q: Can an AIK staff member babysit my child?

A: AIK staff members are not allowed to provide childcare outside of their AIK roles to AIK program participants. *Please see the AIK Parent and Caregiver Handbook for more details.*

Q: Do you offer programming on days when school is not in session?

A: We offer programming on **some** school holidays and breaks at the Girls Inc office, but this is not included in your AIK monthly fees. You can enroll your child in our Meyers Camp program for an additional fee (\$90 per day/per child).
